### Community Involvement

OCPEH strives to have a high degree of transparency, accountability and community involvement in the local CoC grant process.

- Project Review Committee (PRC)
- Leadership Team



## New in 2019, OCPEH, Year-Round PRC

### Purpose:

- Conduct quarterly data reviews of CoC and ESG funded projects
- Establish CoC and ESG rating and ranking tool for new, renewal, consolidated and expansion projects
- Formulate proposed project priority listings for CoC and ESG applications

### Membership:

- 4-8 community members with knowledge of homeless programs and OCPEH priorities
- PRC members cannot have ties to agencies applying for funding
- Term is July 2019 – June 2020 (approximately 2 hours per month)



## Project Review Committee Process

### Scoring

- Use scores to make recommendations to fund or not fund project applications
- PRC will meet on Wednesday, September 20, 2019
- OCPEH Leadership meeting, September 24, 2019

## \$100,000 available with ESG funding

Description of Project Types	Amount	Eligible Applicants
<p><b>Emergency Response &amp; Street Outreach</b> Intended to increase the quantity and quality of temporary emergency shelters operating expenses and essential services</p>	Maximum of 60% total funds available can be spent on these activities	Nonprofits and Government
Meet the immediate needs of unsheltered homeless persons by connecting them with emergency shelter, housing and/or critical health services		
<p><b>Housing Stabilization: Rapid Re-Housing &amp; Homeless Prevention</b> Rental Assistance, housing relocation and stabilization services</p> <p>Aimed to prevent a homeless episode or swiftly stabilize with housing</p>	Maximum of 40% of total funds available can be spent on this activity
