  - Mediware has a new name: WellSky
    - Branding won't change until 2019, at least
  - State ESG Application deadline is October 26<sup>th</sup>
    - Requires third Quarter QPR
  - LSA deadlines released – conditional based on the report not needing fixes upon release
    - First deadline is Nov 9<sup>th</sup>
    - Official deadline is Nov 30<sup>th</sup>
    - Final corrections from Data Quality flags is late January
