- Review of data
 - Animal Services Data- Bob to create visual for presentation
 - Disproportionate number of animals from Hillsborough and OC
 - Harrison is continuing to collect data from surrender forms
 - National Data
 - According to the national data 56% of households will have a pet affected if they lose their housing
 - Sarah will calculate the number of pets in Orange county
 - Potential number of pets becoming homeless each year
 - Orange County Data on Homelessness
 - 269 homeless people were counted in one year
 - 212 of those were homeless for the first time
 - Corey will calculate the numbers for the 2017 calendar year
 - Sarah will use numbers to calculate approximate number of pets becoming homeless
 - 113 days is the average length of time homeless
