- Agency updates
 - IFC-
 - Hotel extension currently until December 2
 - Shelter referrals from HH process
 - Community Link-
 - Permanent supportive housing (PSH) Move-on
 - Replacing PSH voucher with HCV- supports turn-over in PSH program
 - Ready to receive information about program participants to get started in transition process
 - Compass Center
 - Have opened first Safehome Emergency apartment
 - Second one to be opened in January
 - Set to open 3 within fiscal year
 - Recently hired new advocate to better serve Black and African American communities
- OCPEH updates
 - 2020 Homeless Data Review Event – [recording posted on OCPEH website](#)
 - MANY changes to Coordinated Entry afoot, check out CE Retreat meeting notes when they come out if you were unable to attend on 10/30
 - Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) FY 2020-21 RFA submitted to State ESG Office on 10/15
 - \$61,095 for IFC Emergency Shelter
 - \$40,730 for Orange County Rapid Re-housing
- NCCEH Data Center Staff Update
 - OCPEH submitted Longitudinal Systems Analysis (LSA) info October 30 before deadline
 - Reporting on two 12-month periods
 - FY19: Oct. 2018-Sep 2019 and FY20: Oct. 2019- Sep 2020
 - The look back period goes back to Oct 2016
 - Data will be used in Annual Homeless Assessment Report (AHAR) to Congress
 - Now waiting for liaison review, likely NCCEH will send agencies more requested data changes in HMIS

DHHS Coronavirus Relief Funds (CRF) awarded to Orange County

- Orange County was awarded \$195,000 in state Dept. of Health & Human Services CRF funds for the following activities:

- \$19,937 for Rapid Re-housing
- \$30,000 for Emergency Housing Assistance – contact the Housing Helpline for more information
 - Erika Brandt will be available for COVID-19 Coordination meeting for more information re: the program
 - Rent and utility assistance goes through HOPE program (call 211)
- \$5000 for street outreach supplies
 - Tents, tarps, sleeping bags, blankets, etc.
 - Call program phone () for request
- \$57,163 for furniture goods and services
 - [Flyer](#)
 - [Request form](#)
 - Amounts capped by household size/bedrooms
 - Send complete wish list or shopping cart link
 - If service, send quote
- \$15,000 for unit upfits
 - For households with Housing Choice Vouchers (HCV)
 - If unit does not meet HQS inspection, funds can go towards unit repairs to get unit up to standards
- \$50,000 for landlord incentives – contact Anna Patterson, Housing Access Coordinator for more information
 - Signing bonus for landlords working within network of agencies
 - Exact amount of signing bonus in flux
 - anpatterson@orangecountync.gov
- \$4500 for transportation
 - Bus passes, Uber/lyft, specialized+ private services, bikes, vehicle repairs
 - More info coming soon
- \$14,000 for emergency housing for people fleeing Domestic Violence/Sexual Assault
- For costs incurred between March 1-December 30, 2020
- Has to be COVID-19 “tie” to the services/goods
 - Loss of income, need to move to permanent housing and decrease risks associated with COVID
- Expense must be tied to housing
- Need may not be met by another program/service- no duplication of funds

Quarterly data review

- Spending reporting
 - CR to send information out, which will ask about specific grant awards and details about what has been spent
 - To be integrated in to System Performance Matrix

- Compass DV program reporting
 - No existing precedent for procedure
 - Data Collection resources: nccch.org/hmis/admin
 - Guidance available as needed, but will not have access to comparable database
 - Comparable database should be able to pull an APR- these with non-identifiable data can be used
 - Best to supply data on a quarterly basis
 - APR can be added directly to shared sheet
 - APR= Annual Performance Report- Required and detailed report, CoC funding
 - CAPER= specific to ESG funding
 - For assistance with specific guidance, use internal admin support
 - For assistance entering in to matrix and other support, contact NCCEH
 - Compass to have conversation about this for next month
