### Grant timelines are not known exactly until release of ESG RFA & CoC NOFA

- CoC grant process \$700,000 in funding
- Approximate timeline

August Project applications & materials dueAugust Project Review Committee scoring

August Project Review Committee review & rankingAugust Leadership Team review & ranking approval

• September Community application review begins

September Project applications revisions complete

September Staff posts CoC application on OCPEH website for

community review

September Staff submits completed application to HUD

### ESG process to begin in July with Request for Funding Applications (RFA)

- ESG grant process about \$56,000 in funding
- Approximate timeline

End of Sept. Project applications due to OCPEH

October ESG Review Committee begins work of reviewing

project applications and formulating funding recommendation for Leadership Team review

October Leadership Team finalizes ESG funding

recommendation

End October Complete application due to ESG Office



### New for 2019: Standing Project Review Committee

- Purpose
  - · Review and rank ESG and CoC project applications
  - Create proposed list of ranked projects for OCPEH Leadership Team consideration
- Membership
  - 4-8 people
  - Community members with knowledge of homeless programs & priorities
  - Members cannot be affiliated with agencies applying for CoC funding
- Previewed time commitment
  - 12 month duration, July 2019 June 2020
  - · About 2 hours per month, not evenly distributed
    - Quarterly meetings for data review 1.5 hours
    - · Review of project applications 9-15 hours
    - Rating & ranking meetings 2 hours each

#### Updated Draft of Orange County Homeless Services Gaps Analysis

- A few content updates from May draft
  - · Housing Locator marked as filled gap
  - · Updated budget details for medical respite program
  - Updated budget details and project description for Youth Host Homes Program
- Two documents incorporated into one and updated design
- To do
  - · Decide on approach and incorporate budget figures for three gaps
    - · Income-Based Rental Units
    - Day Center with Services
    - · Accessible, Housing-Focused Shelter
  - · Costs for next steps for 24-hour bathrooms
  - · Re-prioritization of gaps



#### Next steps?

- Potential motion to approve update to gaps analysis
- Wait for updated figures and/or re-prioritization
  - Income-Based Rental Units & Downtown Bathrooms could have updated budget in August
  - Day Center with Services could have updated budget in December
  - Accessible & Housing-Focused Shelter could have updated budget in mid- to late 2020
  - Re-prioritization could have info by December
