

UNSHELTERED HOMELESS COUNT (people sleeping on streets, in camps, cars, other places not meant for human habitation)

- All surveys returned to the Partnership to End Homelessness by Thursday, February 8

STREET COUNT

- Wednesday, January 31, 6:00pm-Thursday, February 1, 5:00pm
 - “You Count” Cards will be distributed to folks who come in contact with homeless service providers prior to the count
 - Volunteers will meet at Skills Development Center at 4:30pm Wednesday afternoon for survey training,
 - 5 Teams
 - Chapel Hill-4 teams
 - Carrboro-1 team
 - Northern Orange-1 team
- The teams will survey people living unsheltered at previously-mapped known locations
- Teams will be using paper surveys
- Giveaways (for 30 people; 6-8 sets for each team)
 - Orange County Resource Guide, PTA Thrift Shop Vouchers?, Non-perishable food, Blankets, Bottled water, Hygiene kits, Gloves, hats, Dog biscuits & MREs, Gift cards
- Volunteer training will take place the night of the count
- Survey will include option to receive follow-up services
 - Drop in at the Community Kitchen on Friday, February 2nd.
- Information regarding scheduled one-stop services opportunity will be distributed during count

SERVICE COUNT

- Thursday, February 1st -Tuesday, February 6
 - Fill out surveys with households up to a week after January 31 by asking where they slept on January 31
 - Volunteers to be at the Carrboro Cybrary 10:00 am – 2:00 pm on
 - Thursday February 1
 - Friday February 2
 - Volunteers at Community Kitchen Thursday through Tuesday for lunch shifts (11:00 am – 12:30 pm) and/or dinner shifts (6-7:00 pm)
 - Thursday February 1 – lunch and dinner
 - Friday February 2 – lunch and dinner
 - Saturday February 3 – lunch
 - Monday February 5 – lunch
 - Tuesday February 6 – dinner

SERVICE COUNT, CONT.

SHELTERED HOMELESS COUNT (people staying in emergency shelter, emergency response programs, or transitional housing)

 - Red Cross
 - Compass Center
 - Orange County Schools

RAPID RE-HOUSING (RRH) & PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING (PSH) BED COUNT (to be used in the Housing Inventory Count(HIC))
