Homeless Service System Map Completed with Service Providers



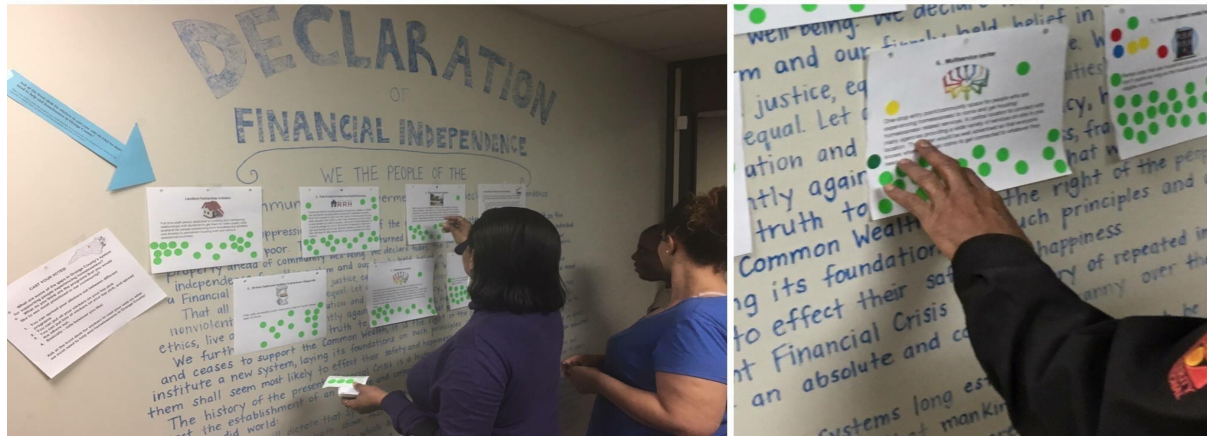
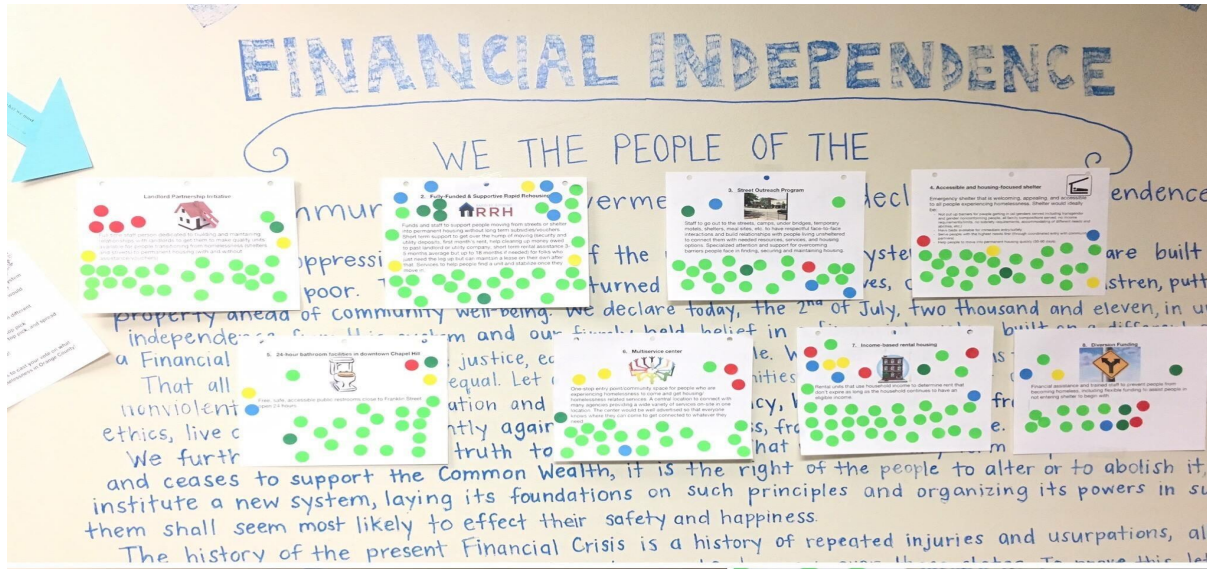
This map shows agencies, pathways and gaps

- Key agencies in system and how they interact
- Pathways from homelessness to housing
- How current system gaps fit into system
- Another version of system map for service providers in OC Connect
 - Program eligibility (Sobriety, Veterans, Domestic Violence, etc.)
 - Population(s) served (Single males, Single females, families)
- Proposal - present map to Towns and County, other interested parties
- Feedback on map

Gaps Analysis

- 8 gaps identified in the course of developing system map
- Prioritized by two groups
 - Service Providers
 - People experiencing homelessness
 - Each person given 8 votes to use in any configuration (8 on one gap, 1 per gap, etc.)
