Defining The Problem

Homelessness comes in many forms and is often hard to label or identify. Whether a person is under-housed, sharing housing with others, or living without shelter at all, one thing is common among all levels: it is harder to overcome the obstacles that homelessness presents when pets are involved.



Major Obstacles

- Finding Affordable Housing that accepts both income-assistance vouchers and pets
- Finding temporary housing that will accept pets when it is necessary for the caretaker to be admitted to a shelter, hospital, or other pet-free facility for a short period of time due to weather, health, or other circumstances
- Easy access to information and navigating the resources available when faced with overcoming these obstacles
